
Capri Sellenger ~ For putting considerable effort into her writing and succeeding in "taking off" in that and other areas.

### **Capri's Wonderful Writing**




Left: You would have noted that Capri (year 1) received a marble for her wonderful writing. You can see why!


### **Playgroup News**
